OVER TO THE NEEDY NATIONS OF THE WORLD. CASTRO SAID THAT MANY OF
THESE UNDEVELOPED NATIONS IN AFRICA, ASIA AND LATIN AMERICA HAVE
BACKED THE QUEST FOR HIGHER OIL PRICES SINCE THEY TO ARE PRODUCERS OF
RAW MATERIALS. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ NOW, CASTRO SAID, THE OIL PRODUCING
NATIONS SHOULD COMPENSATE THE POORER NATIONS BY HELPING THEM OUT
INASMUCH AS THEY NOW HAVE TO PAY MORE FOR OIL ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ AS WELL AS
MORE FOR FOOD AND MACHINERY. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT ANY WORLD
