havana, nov 28, reuter -- cuban president fidel castro told the leaders of the non-aligned nations in a message that he has been informed by mozambique that south african troops are concentrated in the border region of rosano garcia 120 kilometres from maputo in preparation for an attack.

dr. castro, writing as the current head of the ninety-eight nation non-aligned movement called on the united nations +to adopt immediate, pertinent measures to defend the people of mozambique and defeat the ominous designs of the racists.+

+the international community has been aware for a long time of the cowardly and criminal actions of the south african racist regime aimed at destabilizing mozambique, angola and other front line states,+ the cuban leader wrote.

he accused the united states, +strategic ally of south africa, of encouraging these designs by strengthening, politically, militarily and economically, that regime.+ he charged that the u.s. government +has made enormous efforts to ensure south africa a supplementary grant of more than one billion dollars by the international monetary fund, thus scoffing at the resolutions of the united nations and ignoring the indignant and growing reaction of the racist apartheid regime.+

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
