~~Fidel~~ Prime Minister Fidel Castro radiated optimism ~~today~~ as he spoke in commemoration of the ~~twentieth~~ twenty second anniversary of the attack on the Moncada Barracks. With a broad smile on his face he said that the Cuban revolution is going well, that it is stronger ^{now} than ever and that the ~~people~~ Cuban people are more enthusiastic about it than ever. He spoke before a half million people in Cuba's central Las Villas province. Castro said that the economic growth rate has risen sharply over the past few years. He noted that the price of crude sugar on the world market is falling and that this might affect the rate of economic growth in the future but declared that economy will continue to grow even though ^{CUBAN} ~~it~~ ⁱⁿ ~~be~~ ~~at~~ ~~a~~ ~~slower~~ ~~rate~~.
