On January 2nd there ~~xxx~~ was a big military parade marking the 20th anniversary of the Cuban revolution in Havana's revolution square.

Raul Castro, The minister of the Cuban armed forces made the key note speech. What he said was largely a repetition of what Fidel Castro said the day before. On this occasion also, the Chinese diplomats walked out on the speech.

These were the tanks ~~xxxxx~~ roaring by the reviewing stand. During ~~ixx~~ military parade, the Cubans showed off their latest arsenal of soviet made weapons ---new types of tanks, personnel carriers, rocket launchers and heavy duty helicopters. And then, despite the tremendous downpour, ~~the~~ Cuba's Mig 23's flew by over Revolution Sqaure at low altitude.
