The service message: Cuban president Fidel Castro spoke to the Cuban communist party congress which began tuesday for over eight hours which made rumours ~~that~~ that he is gravely ill seem highly exaggerated. ~~Castro~~ He also spoke about U.S. Cuban relations ~~and other matters~~ and other matters touched on in Pres. Reagans state of the union address:

That is fidel castro saying that like it or not the United States will have to resign itself to accepting a revolutionary duba and a changing world.

Dr. Castro said Cuba wants better relations with the American people but he said cuba would not ~~approach~~ seek those relat ons at the expense of its friendship with the Soviet union and nations such as nicaragua and angola. He accused the Reagan administration of being paranoic about Cuba and of being the root cause of the conflicts going on in Central America. Fidel Castro also said Cuba ~~would~~ ^{was ready to} withdraw most of its troops from Angola if south africa ~~abided~~ ^{abided} by united nations resolutions and got out of namibia. He ~~also~~ ^{accused} ~~called~~ Jonas Savimbi, the leader The UNITA movement which is battling the Angolan government of sowing death in ~~the~~ Angola and of being a mercenary for South Africa and the United States. ~~This~~
