President Castro, dressed in ~~usual~~^{CUSTOMARY} his ~~accustomed~~ army fatigues launched his strongest attack on record against President Reagan and He declared that Mr Reagan acts as if we lived in the times of Buf Bill his foreign policy. He said the Reagan administration was responsible for aiding and ~~betting~~ terrorist activities in central americian nations such as el salvador/where ~~with~~ right wing death squads have killed thousands of people and where several americans, including some nuns, were murdered.

Fidel Castro also said the contra supported by the united states in their war against the ~~legitimate~~ ~~regime~~ of Nicaraguan sandanista regime were ~~guilt~~ of atrocities. Dr. Castro said the United States has sabotaged all attempts of the contadora group to find a peaceful negotiated settlement to the Nicaraguan ~~in~~ problem. ~~They don't want~~ President Reagan ~~doesn't~~ want ~~an~~ ~~evolution~~, ~~he~~ ~~said~~ The only solution President Reagan wants, he said, is that of overthrowing the ~~Nicaraguan~~ legitimate nicaraguan government.

The Cuban leader ~~noted~~ that the U.S. House of Representatives had ~~changed~~ ~~their~~ ~~vote~~ to favour financial aid to the contras fighting the Nicaragua government. ~~He~~ ~~said~~ in part, because of Nicaraguan He said the decision to reverse the vote showed cowardliness but president ortegas visit to Moscow, ~~He~~ ~~said~~ Dr. Ortega had made a mistake ~~in~~ ~~not~~ ~~announcing~~ beforehand that the trip to Moscow had been planned ~~well~~ in advance and that it dealt mainly with ~~assuring~~^{guaranteeing} Nicaraguas petroleum supply.
