This is Lionel Martin in Havana, the service message -- the repatriations of cubans who were prisoners on Grenada is ~~expected~~ winding down. here is the story.

The eight plane carrying the last of the Cubans ~~prisoners~~ who were prisoners on Grenada arrived ~~here~~ was met, like all the others by a military ~~honour~~ band and honour guard. Fidel Castro has personally welcome with a hug or a firm handshake every one of the 731 Cubans who have returned from Grenada.

It is expected that one more flight from Barbados, where the Cubans on Grenada are taken by U.S. military planes, will complete the process of repatriation. There are now less than 30 Cuban diplomats on Grenada and it is understood they are trying to arrange for the return of the 25 Cuban dead.

Loudspeakers were being put up in revolution square ~~today~~ which is ~~proof~~ positive proof that there will be a mass rally there. Speculation is that it will take place on Thursday. and that Cuban leader Fidel Castro, will speak.

Dr. Castro has not spoke to reporters or made any public comments since the repatriation procedures began a week ago. But ~~most~~ people it is almost certain that once ~~that~~ the repatriation is complete, the Cuban president will tell the Cuban people and the world, in a long speech, just what he thinks about Grenada events. ~~The~~ Cubans to whom I spoke are expecting him to make an analysis of the Grenada situation which will include ~~the~~ ^{the Cuban view on} ~~the intervention~~ the murder of former prime minister Maurice Bishop and the U.S. intervention on the island.
