BANKABA HOLDS CONVERSATIONS AND VISITS COUNCIL OF STATE
BAHAMA, NOV 14, DETER. THE LEADER OF THE AFRICAN UNION AT
BUKINA FASO, CAPTAIN THOMAS BANKABA MET WITH PUBLIC MINISTER
OF THE ARMED FORCES, PAUL CASTRO, LAST NIGHT IN BAHAMA THE HONORABLE

BANKABA ARRIVED IN BAHAMA ON THURSDAY MORNING, TWO DAY VISIT

IS THE HIGH RANKING OFFICIAL IN BOTH THE CUBAN COMMUNIST PARTY AND
GOVERNMENT. ALSO PRESENT AT THE MEETING WERE GENERAL
MIGUEL ROSALES DEL TORO, DEPUTY HEAD OF THE CUBAN ARMY FORCES AND
