THIRD WORLD FILM AND TELEVISION SCHOOL UNDER CONSTRUCTION:

HAVANA, SEPT. 14, REUTER -- A SCHOOL WHICH WILL TRAIN MEN AND WOMEN FROM THE THIRD WORLD FOR FILM MAKING AND TELEVISION WORK WILL BE COMPLETED BY MID ~~AUGUST~~ ^{NOVEMBER} IN SAN ANTONIO DE BANOS TO THE SOUTH OF HAVANA, JUVENTUD REBELDE ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE SCHOOL WILL BELONG TO THE FOUNDATION OF LATIN AMERICAN FILM WHICH WAS ORGANISED IN HAVANA LAST DECEMBER. ITS PURPOSE, AS ANNOUNCED AT THE TIME, IS TO TRAIN AND ENCOURAGE FILM MAKERS FROM LATIN AMERICA, AFRICA AND ASIA.

THE SCHOOL, WITH A TOTAL CAPACITY FOR 250 STUDENTS, WILL INITIATE ITS FIRST COURSE WITH 140 STUDENTS FROM 20 NATIONS FROM LATIN AMERICA AND THE REST OF THE THIRD WORLD.

THE NEWSPAPER SAID THAT THE COST OF BUILDING AND EQUIPPING THE SCHOOL WILL BE 2.2 MILLION DOLLARS. IT WILL HAVE SIX BUILDINGS WHICH WILL INCLUDE CLASSROOMS, LABORATORIES, THEATERS, DORMITORIES AND A LARGE CAFETERIA.
